DESCRIPTION:

This project widened and reconstructed Geary Road to provide one through lane in each direction, a two way left turn lane, bike lanes, parking and sidewalks along Geary Road from North Main Street to Pleasant Hill Road. The project was constructed in two phases. The first phase was locally funded and is located between North Main Street and Pioneer Avenue. The second phase was funded with local funds and Measure C funds and is located between Pioneer Avenue and Putnam Boulevard. A future project, phase three, is partially funded with local funds and is located between Putnam Boulevard and Pleasant Hill Road. The City will be pursuing other funding sources for the third phase.
