RE: Support for the Contra Costa Transportation Authority's Grant Application for the USDOT's Competitive Multimodal Project Discretionary Program for *Innovate 680* program

Dear Secretary Buttigieg:

We write regarding the Contra Costa Transportation Authority's (CCTA) application to the United States Department of Transportation's (USDOT) Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant (MPDG) program for the *Innovate 680* program.

The *Innovate 680* program promotes a holistic approach to improving mobility and creating more sustainable, shared modes of transportation. *Innovate 680* will fund a suite of multimodal projects along Interstate 680 (I-680) – a backbone corridor in the San Francisco Bay Area that bisects all of Contra Costa County and transports many constituents to, from, or through districts we represent– to modernize the corridor for the future. The corridor experiences significant delays and inconsistent flow of traffic in both directions, and these delays are expected to continue in the foreseeable future.

To address these challenges, three projects within *Innovate 680* have great potential to provide immediate public benefit. These projects are designed to work in harmony together to improve safety, smooth traffic, and increase access for all users of the transportation system. Specific projects include three shared mobility hubs that support first and last mile connections to zero emission hydrogen transit, coordinated adaptive ramp metering to reduce congestion on I-680; and completion of an express lane network. These key elements of *Innovate 680* complement each other by strengthening regional multimodal connections and reducing barriers to alternative mode use.

With over \$154 million in future state, other federal, and regional funding already committed, CCTA is seeking approximately \$213 million from the MPDG opportunity.

The *Innovate 680* program aligns with USDOT's efforts to advance infrastructure projects of regional significance with economic, mobility, and safety benefits, and is poised to reduce travel time and environmental emissions, while enhancing the region's economic vitality. Importantly, *Innovate 680* is designed to prepare the I-680 corridor for the future with innovative solutions to foster multimodal transportation options, reduce vehicle-miles traveled, reduce greenhouse gas

emissions and air pollution, and increase equity and access for historically disadvantaged and underserved communities.

We respectfully request this application be given your full and thorough review, and we trust that it will receive the fair consideration it deserves. Thank you for taking the time to consider our thoughts on this matter.
